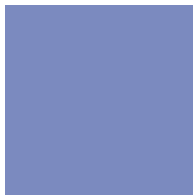




Allied Health Summit – Leadership and Practice Innovation in Action

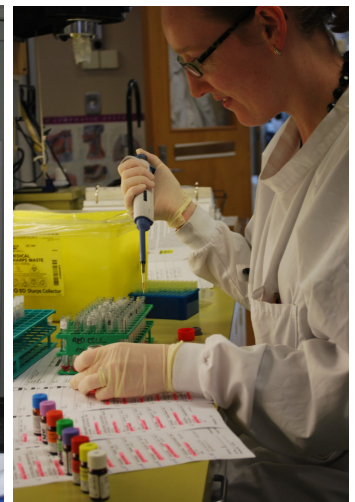


**Capital and Coast DHB Lecture Theatre
